OUR TEXAS DPS MEMORIAL SERVES AS A BRIDGE BETWEEN LAW ENFORCEMENT AND CIVILIANS, EDUCATING VISITORS ABOUT THE ONGOING SACRIFICES AND CHALLENGES OF THOSE WHO MADE THE ULTIMATE SACRIFICE.



The Texas DPS Memorial has been lovingly designed to represent all facets of the DPS family, and will rival national monuments. The foundation of the monument will be a 77' circle of native granite anchored in the center by an 11 foot tall bronze Texas DPS Trooper paying his respect to an historic tombstone representing the first fallen peace officer in Texas - a Texas Ranger.

On the outer perimeter of the granite circle will be 3 separate granite and bronze panels depicting scenes from the history of DPS. Each panel is engraved with a core value - Protection, Courtesy, and Service. The corresponding bronze work for each panel will honor a different theme. The first panel will honor the 11,000 current civilian staff members at DPS. The second depicts a legendary Texas Ranger looking to the future with his hand on a young, modern-day Trooper. The third panel displays an homage to all current DPS capabilities such as aircraft, drones, and K9 units. To learn more, please scan the QR code on this page.
